Application Process

- 1. Visit montclair.edu/apply and create an account
- 2. Complete and submit your application and application fee
- 3. Upload required documents (varies by program)
 - Transcripts from any U.S. college or university attended
 - Course-by-course transcript evaluation and degree equivalency from a member of **naces.org** or by **educatedchoices.com** (required for any non-U.S. credentials).
 - English proficiency exam*
 - Standardized test scores: GRE or GMAT (if required by major)
 - Personal statement/essay
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Resume

* Applicants who have earned their undergraduate or graduate degree from an institution where English is not the official language of instruction will be required to submit proof of English proficiency. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or Duolingo English Test scores are accepted.
