MBA-IT Program at Ottawa University

The MBA-IT program at the Kansas City campus in Overland Park, Kansas, is a limited enrollment, cohort-based program that offers a comprehensive blend of business education and information technology expertise. With a focus on integrating personal values, professional ethics, global business perspectives, communication skills, and IT fundamentals, it equips students with the knowledge and skills necessary to excel in their current and future careers.

Admission Requirements

Bachelor's Degree:

- Provide all Degree Certificates and Marks Sheets (Scanned Copies are Acceptable)
- Equivalent to U.S. 4-year Degree; Equivalent Min. GPA of 3.0 (Will accept students with 3-year bachelor's degrees only if the degree has been earned in Division I and the awarding institution has been accredited by India's National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a grade of "A" or better)
- Min. Course Completion Rate (Earned-to-Attempted Percentage) = 80%
- If transferring from an accredited institution that has issued an I-20, students must submit their I-20 from their current school as well as their I-94 and FI visa stamp.

English Language Requirement:

- TOEFL 79
- IELTS: Overall - 6.5 (Min. Subsection - 5.5)
- Duolingo: Overall - 110 (Min. Subsection - 95)
- Virtual interview may be requested if any subsection score is below minimum

Statement of Purpose - Original Writing, Maximum 2-page, double spaced essay describing your sense of purpose at Ottawa University

Letters of Recommendation - 3

No GRE/GMAT needed

Evidence of financial support (dated within last 3 months)

- Bank statement or letter from the bank
- Signed affidavit from sponsor including sponsor's name, their relationship to the student, the amount they intend to fund, and a statement confirming that they will be funding the applicant for the purpose of their studies in the U.S. The affidavit should also be dated within the last three months.

Tuition and Fees: \$18,815

Living Expenses: \$12,420

Health Insurance: \$1,000

Post-Completion of the MBA-IT

Upon degree completion, Eligible F-1 students who finish their program of study and participate in an initial period of regular post-completion OPT (for 12 months) have the option to apply for a STEM OPT extension (for an additional 24 months), if no previous OPT has been awarded at the graduate (master's) level
